OSHA requires all labs to have a Chemical Hygiene Plan (CHP). This written plan describes the safety procedures specific to your lab operations. Yes, school labs are included in this federal requirement. In NYS, this regulation is enforced by NYS DOL Public Employee Safety & Health (PESH).

If your school has a CHP and its time for its required annual update, or if your school still doesn't have one, the Laboratory Safety Institute (a very good resource for lab safety) is offering schools a free copy of their model CHP to use as a template.
