

Announcing the 2020 LISEF – Broadcom MASTERS

A Science Fair for Middle School Students

Sponsored by the Long Island Science and Engineering Fair,
Society for Science & the Public, and Broadcom

The Society for Science and the Public (SSP) has partnered with Broadcom to launch the Broadcom MASTERS™ National Middle School Science and Engineering Competition.

This program is open to students in grades 6, 7, and 8.

Under the guidance of their science teachers, students perform a science investigation. The results of the investigation are presented at the LISEF – SSP Broadcom MASTERS Fair.

When: The LISEF – SSP Broadcom MASTERS Fair will take place on **Thursday, March 12, 2020.**

Where: Crest Hollow Country Club, Woodbury, New York.

- Liaison and Student registration opens on the website on **November 1, 2019**. Each school may send up to **ten (10)** projects. Students may compete as individuals or as members of a team (maximum of three (3) students/team) from the same school.
- Each school MUST have a school liaison.
- Depending on the number of registered projects, send between 1 and 3 teachers who will act as a judge at the Fair.
- The fee for the program is \$50 *per student*. LISEF – SSP is BOCES aid-able. (School districts can pay the application fee through BOCES. If paying through BOCES, the fee is \$55 per student; this cost is inclusive of the BOCES administrative fees.) Fees (or BOCES Forms) must be received no later than **Friday, March 6, 2020**.
- TEACHER ONLINE APPLICATION REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS **Wednesday, January 22, 2020 @ 8:00 p.m.** All participants (including members of a team) must be students affiliated with a Nassau or Suffolk County educational institution.
- Students whose projects earn top honors at the LISEF – SSP Fair will advance to the National competition. Details about National program can be found at the SSP web site: <http://www.societyforscience.org/masters>

How Does Your School Participate?

- Complete the on-line registration form and select the appropriate payment method, which can be found at the LISEF web site, www.lisef.org.
- Have students conduct a science research project, prepare a presentation board that describes the experiment, and be ready to orally communicate their findings at the LISEF-SSP Broadcom MASTERS Fair.
- Come to the LISEF-SSP Broadcom MASTERS Fair at Crest Hollow Country Club on Thursday, March 12, 2020.
- Depending on the number of registered projects, send between 1 and 3 teachers who will act as a judge at the Fair.
